Chaperone Policy

Thank you so much for volunteering to chaperone our band students. You are an integral and necessary part of this program. The following is a guideline for you to follow in assisting the staff and the students.

*Chaperones are required to be Level II Volunteers. You must have applied and been approved for Level II Volunteer by Greenville County School District. (https://www.greenville.k12.sc.us/Parents/main.asp?titleid=volunteers)

- 1. Make sure to have a medical kit and medical forms for every student.
- 2. The role of the chaperone is not to enforce discipline but to ensure the safety of our students.
- 3. If there is a discipline issue, the staff should be notified immediately.
- 4. Students are coached and instructed as to the procedures at events. They are aware of what is expected of them. Please do not interfere with this process.
- 5. Couples are not allowed to sit together on the bus. No "PDA" at any time.
- 6. All school rules are to be followed. If there is an issue, please notify the staff immediately.
- 7. Make sure water is provided at every event.
- 8. Make sure students have food and/or money to eat with. Usually, the booster club will have extra food and/or money for students that have a need.
- 9. If the event is lengthy, make sure food, and/or snacks, and water is available.
- 10. Please allow student leadership to do their jobs.
- 11. Students must follow the expectations given in the band handbook.
